His lecture will be given at Seattle Central in the Library from 2:30 – 4:30 and if you need a parking pass, please let me know right away. Refreshments will be served and faculty will receive Faculty Development salary credit for attending.

The application for faculty who want to attend the **Rich Media Summer Institute** is now online and I'll provide a link to it in my podcast "play notes.". The deadline for applying is Monday, June 12. We are encouraging faculty teams who want to develop and share a project to apply. The Institute will be hosted by South Campus this year and will immediately follow the end of Summer Quarter. The specific dates are Tuesday, August 22 till noon on Friday, August 25. Faculty who attend will receive about \$200 worth of technology tools from 2GB flash drives to MP3 players to digital voice recorders to headsets with microphones. The focus of the Institute is creating digital video and audio content that can be burned to CD or DVD, streamed online, or delivered as a podcast. The application has more information and some project examples to use for inspiration.
