I'll add a link to it from the course web site. If you want to get your final grade earlier you must give me permission in an email message so I can send it to you.

With the exception of the online lectures and resources only found in WebCT, you'll have access to all the other resources found on the course web site. I'm planning to teach IT 111 Spring quarter so I'll be updating and adding to the course web site as I've done this quarter.
